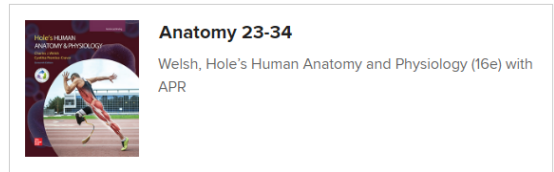


Anatomy Summer Work 23-24

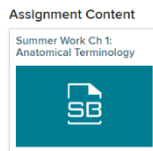
1. Go to <https://my.mheducation.com/> to access our textbook website.

- c. If you added Anatomy to your schedule over the summer you can add yourself to the class by using this code: WFQHNJR2

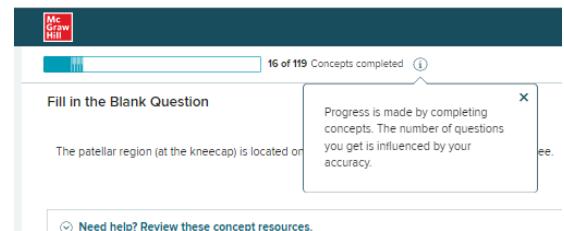


2. Click on our Text/Class
3. You have 3 assignments to assignments to complete. They may be done in any order. Click on the Blue box to open the questions.

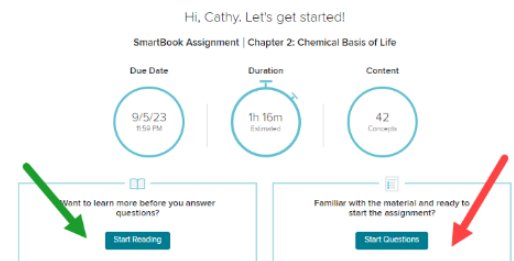
- a. Ch 1 Anatomical Terminology

- c. Ch 3 The Cell Review



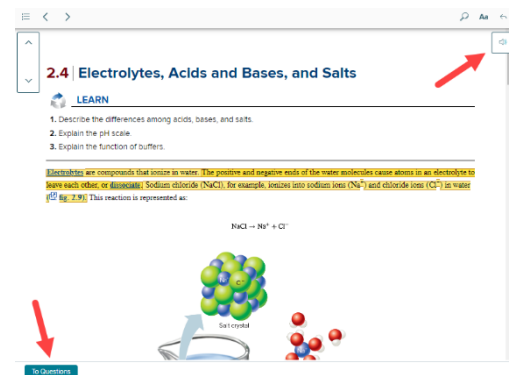
4. For each assignment you will have a series of questions to answer, the total number of questions you are asked depends on how many you answer correctly. So, take your time and access the text to facilitate your work. For each question answered incorrectly you will be asked more questions until the concepts are understood.



5. You may choose to review some of the text before working on the questions by clicking on the Start Reading button on the left side. Or you can Start Questions then review the text only when needed.



6. In the text you may choose to listen to the text by clicking on the speaker icon in the top right corner. You will notice material that is covered in the questions is highlighted in the text. You may return to the questions when ready by clicking on the To Questions in the bottom left corner of the text.



7. You may stop at any point; all progress will be saved.
