The Management Fee shall be calculated at the end of each Accounting Period during the school year and prorated for any partial Accounting Period. Partial Accounting Period shall be defined as a period of time less than one (1) month.

GUARANTEE: District and Sodexo shall work together to ensure a financially sound operation and shall guarantee financial results for the 2010-2011 school year as follows.
